Privacy and Cookie Policy

The following privacy policy applies to all website visits, transactions, and agreements with Wanscale B.V., Straatweg 60, 3604 BV Maarssen, The Netherlands, 66117003.

Your privacy

We respect the privacy of our website visitors and ensure that the personal information you provide is treated confidentially. Below, you can read how we do this and which personal data we collect from you for which purposes.

The Use of Personal Data

When using our website www.wanscale.com, we obtain certain information from you. This can include personal data. We only store and use the personal data provided directly by you within the context of the service you have requested (e.g., through the contact form or to create an account) or data that is explicitly provided to us for processing. We will not use your personal data for other purposes unless you have given prior permission, or if we are required or allowed to do so by law or agreement.

Purposes of Use

To serve you optimally, it is sometimes necessary for Wanscale to store your personal data. Wanscale uses your personal data for:

- providing access to our website and/or portal;
- enabling functionalities on our website and/or portal;
- executing agreements, transactions, and services;
- relationship management, including contacting you at your request;
- gaining insight into website usage;
- sending newsletters.

We only process your personal data if there is a valid legal basis, such as your consent, the necessity to perform an agreement, or compliance with a legal obligation. We do not retain your data longer than necessary for the purposes mentioned above.

Description of Personal Data

For the purposes listed above, we process the following personal data:

- name and address details;
- company details;
- VAT number;
- job title;
- gender;
- email address;
- (mobile) phone number;
- date of birth;

- IP-address;
- technical browser information;
- cookie ID;
- click and surfing behavior;

Retention Periods

We do not retain your personal data longer than necessary to achieve the purposes outlined in this privacy and cookie policy.

Confidentiality & Disclosure to Third Parties

We treat your personal data with confidentiality. The personal data collected via our website will not be shared with third parties for direct marketing purposes. Furthermore, we will not disclose the data you provide to other parties unless you have given prior consent, it is necessary for executing the agreement, or we are required or allowed to do so by law or agreement.

Data Security

Wanscale employs careful security procedures to protect processed data, ensuring that unauthorized access is prevented. We ensure that only necessary personnel have access to your data and that access to your personal data is safeguarded. At a minimum, we use a TLS connection.



Cookies

On www.wanscale.com, cookies are used to analyze statistics and visitor behavior to improve website functionality and user experience. Cookies are small information files that can automatically be stored on or read from your device (including a PC, tablet, or smartphone) when visiting a website. This happens via the web browser on your device. The information a cookie collects about your website use can be transferred to Wanscale's secured servers or those of a third party.

On our website, cookies are used to:

- enable website functionalities and protect the website (technical or functional cookies);
- analyze website usage and improve the website accordingly (analytical cookies);

Technical or Functional Cookies

The main purpose of cookies is to save you time and effort. For example, if you adjust a web page to your preferences or navigate through a website, (functional) cookies remember your chosen settings and preferences for future use. The cookies retrieve the data entered earlier so you can easily use the website as previously set up.

Analytical Cookies

Analytical cookies are used to track statistics, giving us insights into website usage and campaign effectiveness.

Enabling and Disabling Cookies

You can choose whether or not to accept cookies. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser settings to decline cookies if you prefer (check your browser help page for instructions). If you choose not to accept cookies, you may not be able to fully use the interactive features of this website or other websites you visit.

Deleting Cookies

Most cookies have an expiration date. This means they will automatically expire after a certain period and no longer record data about your site visit. You can also choose to delete cookies manually before the expiration date. For more information, consult your browser's manual.

Links to Other Websites

We cannot guarantee these third parties handle your personal data in a reliable or secure manner. We recommend reading the privacy policies of these websites before using them.
